Camp STAT (Summer Therapeutic Activities for Teens) is a special education summer camp designed for adolescents with high-functioning Autism Spectrum Disorder for whom socialization is difficult. Daily activities may include social skills training, therapeutic activities, outdoor recreation time, computer time, indoor and tabletop games and activities, weekly community outings, field trips, and weekly trips to a local community swimming pool. Campers will practice daily life skills by preparing some of their own lunches and snacks.

Specially-trained staff provide individualized programming for each teen, teaching social interactions, social communication skills, coping skills, emotional regulation, problem solving skills and behavioral competencies through facilitated participation in age-appropriate activities and community outings.
