Seminar Objectives

Participants will be able to:

- Describe the characteristics of autism
- Explain classroom assessment of children with autism
- Demonstrate structured teaching techniques
- Understand the importance of working cooperatively with families of children with autism
- Describe the communication deficits, assess expressive communication and develop teaching techniques to address behaviors
- Use structured teaching techniques to promote students' independence as well as develop skills for leisure activities
- Describe behavior management strategies and various levels of social interaction.

Seminar Format

Attendees will have the opportunity to participate in an intensive, hands-on learning experience under the supervision of distinguished team of instructors, led by a training director from the TEACCH Autism Program at the University of North Carolina.

The seminar is a combination of classroom instruction, observation and hands-on practice in a demonstration classroom, with time built in to share strategies with peers and consult with the Watson Institute's team of experts. Three days of the training are reserved for trainees to work directly with children with autism spectrum disorder of varying ages and functioning levels. This enables attendees to practice their newly-learned skills in a real life setting.

Tuition: \$1900.00

Tuition includes seminar materials, continental breakfast, lunch, and break refreshments.
