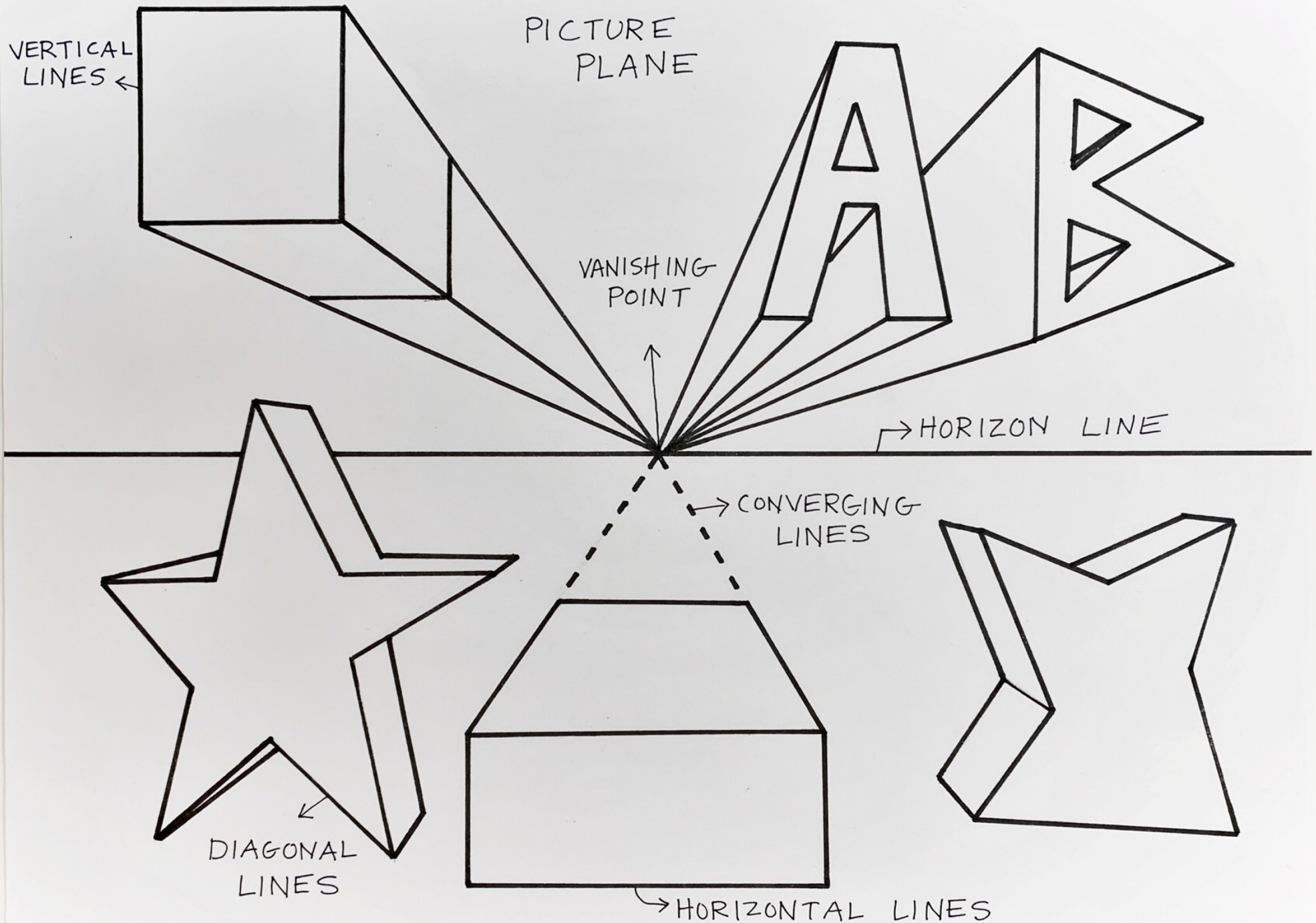

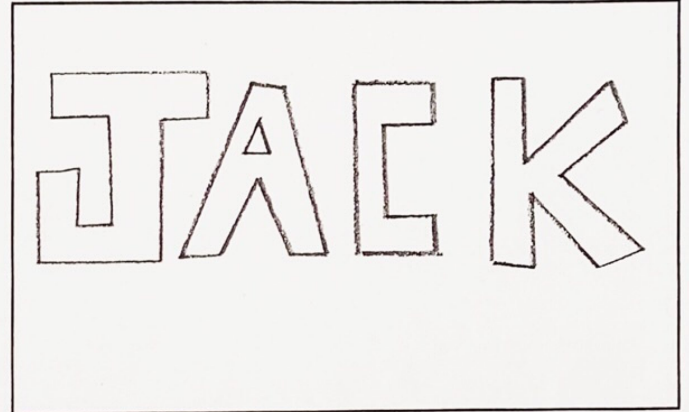

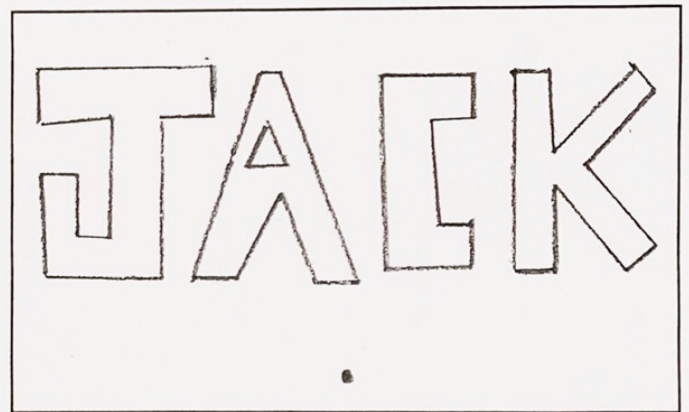
1. Draw your name in block letters using a ruler for each line.

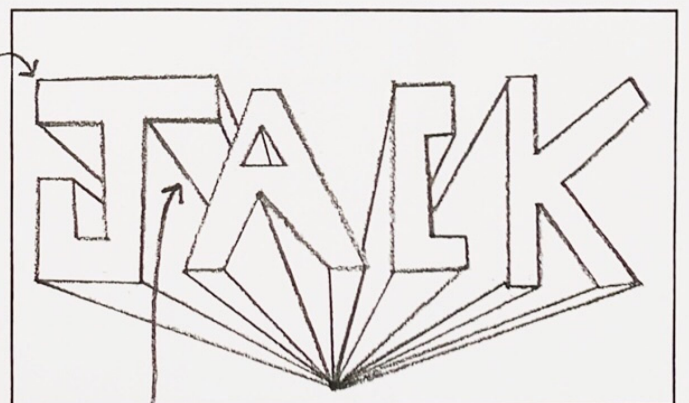


3. Draw **converging lines** shooting off each corner of each letter to the vanishing point.

When there is another letter in the path of the converging line, continue drawing your line then **STOP** at that letter that is in your path.

One-Point Perspective Vocabulary

1. **PERSPECTIVE** – the illusion of distance or depth on a flat surface.
2. **PICTURE PLANE** – the drawing or painting surface of a flat, two dimensional picture.
3. **HORIZON LINE** – where the land and sky meet.
4. **VANISHING POINT** – the point where converging lines meet.
5. **CONVERGING LINES** – lines that point toward the vanishing point.
6. **VERTICAL LINES** – a straight line that goes up and down.
7. **HORIZONTAL LINE** – a straight line that is parallel to the horizon line.
8. **DIAGONAL LINES** – any straight line that is not parallel to the horizon line and is not vertical.
