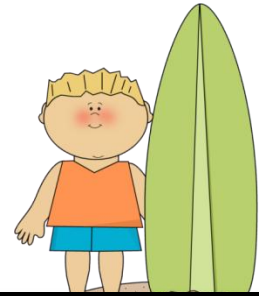




# Verbs

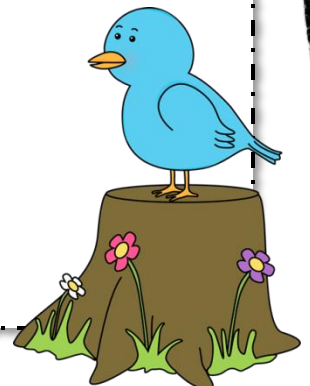
