

# Core Vocabulary Tip



## Story Idea: “I Like You”

Story book	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read the story “I like you”</li><li>• When you have finished reading the book, ask the student “what / who they like?”</li><li>• See who likes the same /different things</li></ul>

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How to Model Core Words	<p>Use student’s communication system to talk to them using the core words</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Examples: “what like?”, “What do you like?”, “I like it”, “take turn”, “Not like”, “I like you”, “I like different”, “Like same”</li></ul>														

## Activity Ideas:

Ideas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• “Like” Safari – affix pictures of friends on post-its around the environment, find all of them and have students say “like” each time they find a friend’s picture</li><li>• “Like” Silly Faces – The student tells the group to “go” to do a silly face, everyone looks at each other’s silly face and comments if they “like” it, the student then calls out to do “more” and everyone does another silly face, etc.</li><li>• Opinion poll, e.g. “Which do you like?”, “which do you not like?”, etc.</li></ul>
