Student-Focused Consultation

- Observation of students with educational or behavioral challenges within a variety of settings to offer solutions to the educational team
- Assist with Individualized Education Plans (IEP) and Positive Behavior Support Plans
- Participation in and consultation during IEP or Educational Team meetings
- Crisis intervention consultation

Classroom-Focused Consultation

- Classroom observations that provide recommendations to educators with students in a variety of settings
- Provide and teach:
- Development and effective use of the classroom environment
- Effective instructional strategies
- Positive behavior guidance
- Promotion of social interaction and social skills training
- Effective strategies for communication
