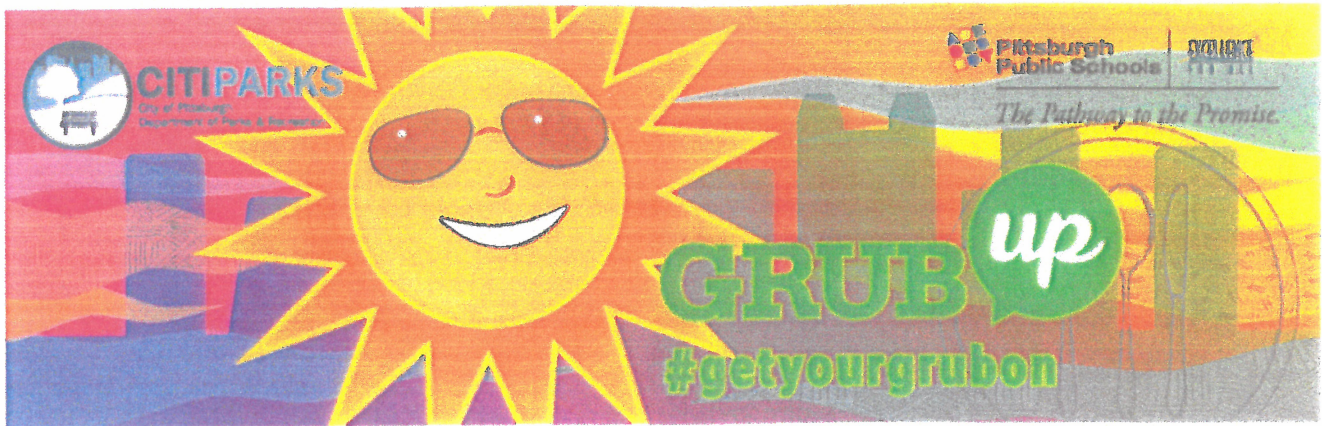


# Summer Food Program
