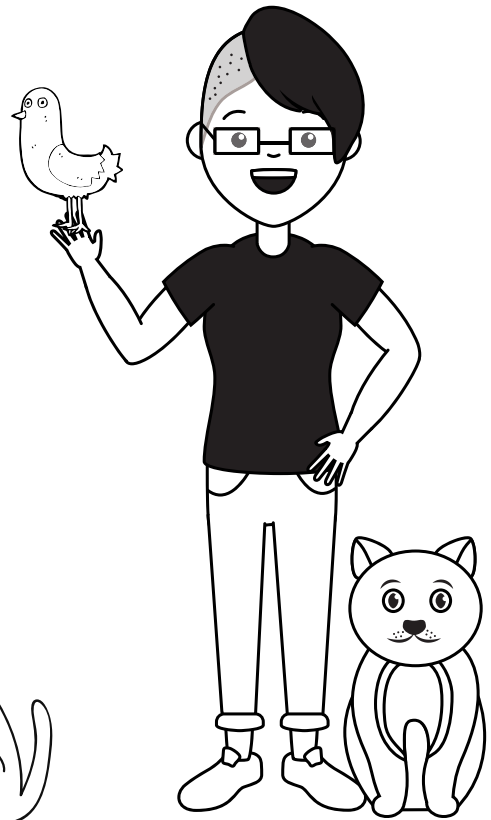
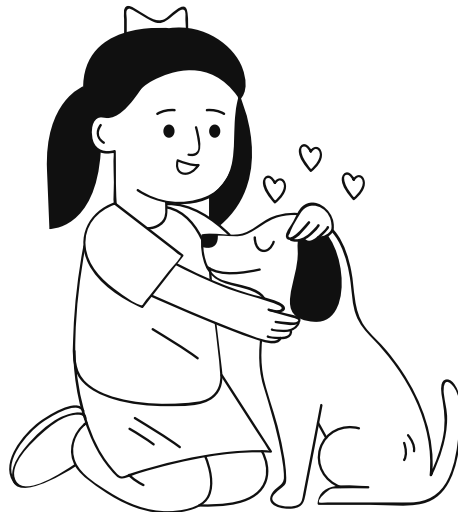




This is my friend, Elmer.

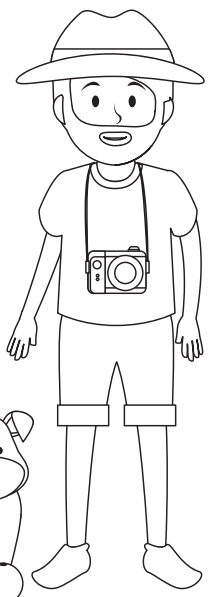
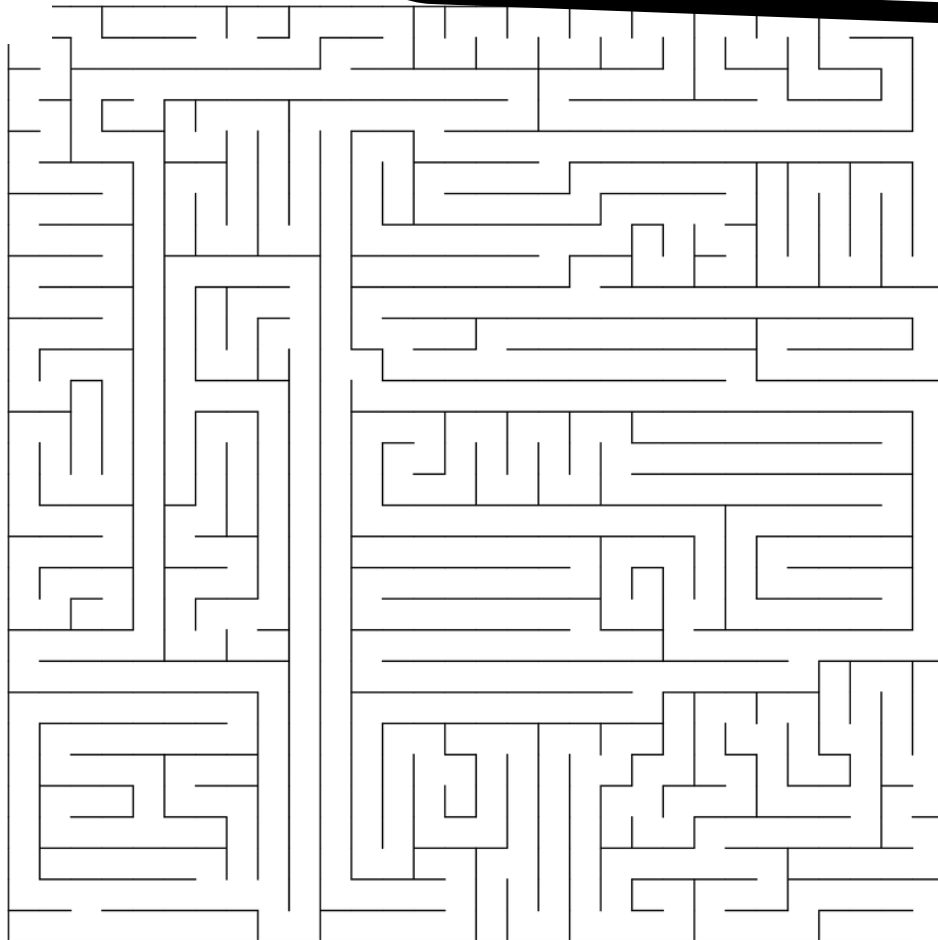

They need a place to live and friends to play with.

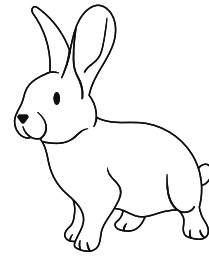

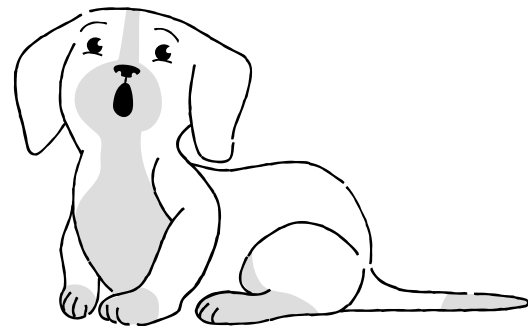
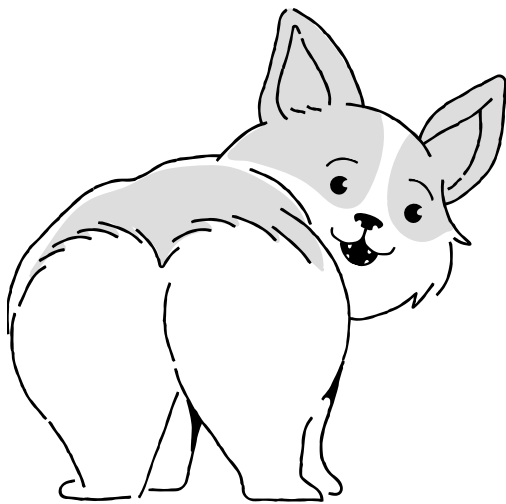
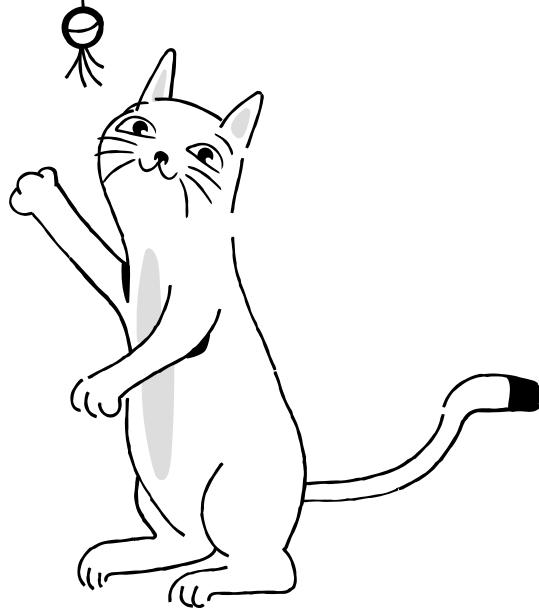


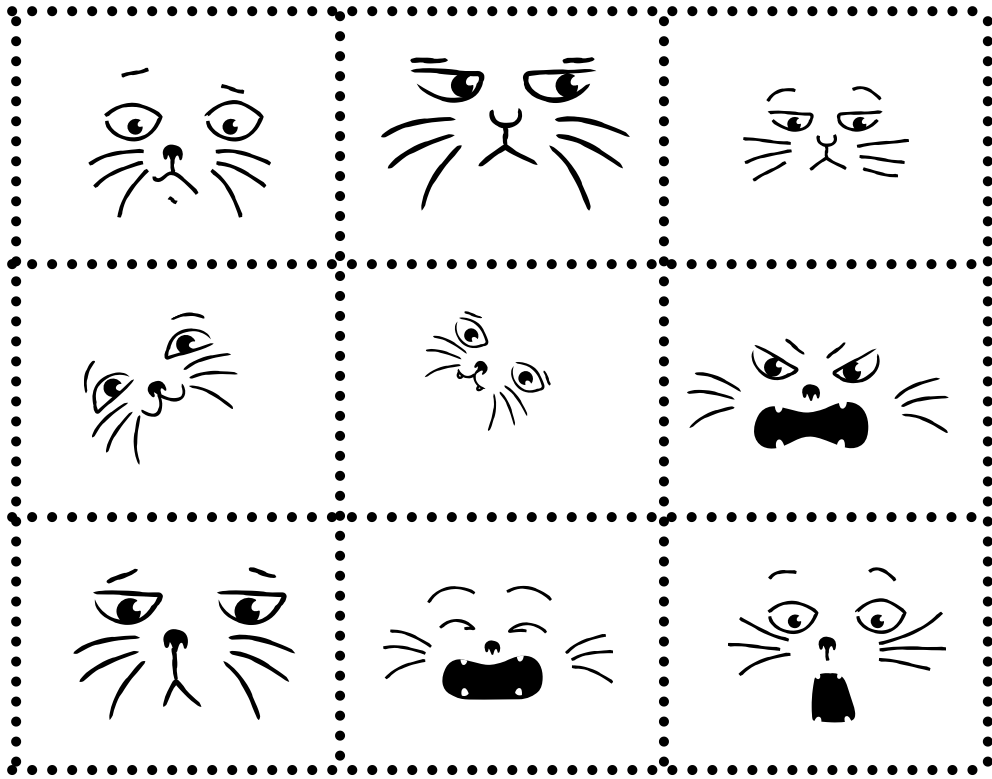
Turtles are some of the oldest animals around. As pets, certain species of turtles can live to be 10-150+ years old!



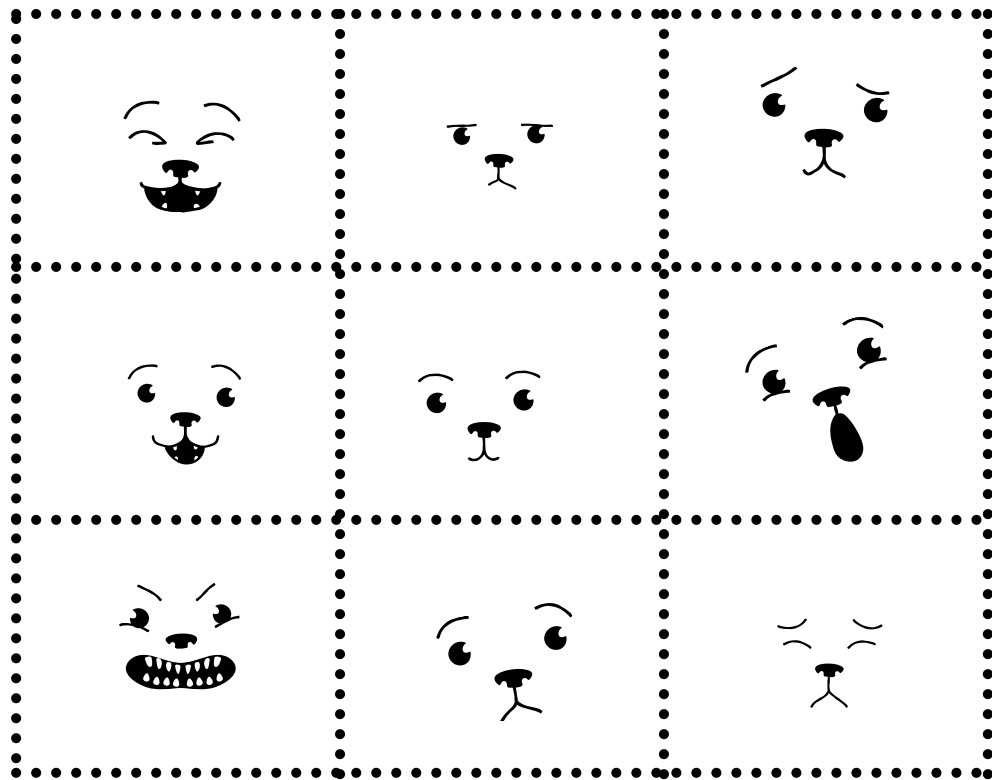

Did you know?

An un-spayed female cat can begin to have kittens at 6 months old, and can give birth to an average of 6 kittens per litter every 2.5 months!

That adds up to a lot of cats if no one is being spayed or neutered.

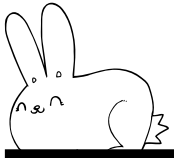
Once upon a time, a family found a young cat living in their garage. They adopted the cat and named her Pepper. The family loves Pepper very much, but - oh no! - they didn't spay her! Shortly after moving in with her new family, Pepper has her **first litter of 6 kittens**.

Three months later, Pepper still isn't spayed, and she has another **litter with 4 more kittens**. A few more months pass, it is now springtime (A.k.a. "kitten season") and Pepper has **5 more kittens, AND her first litter of 6 kittens has 5 kittens each!**

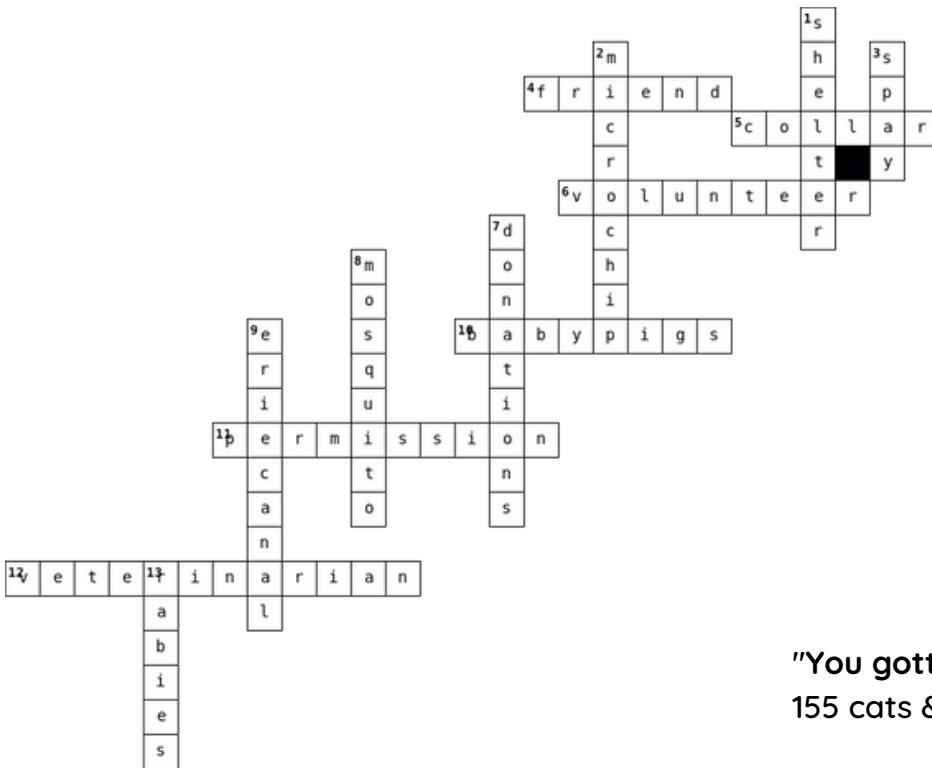
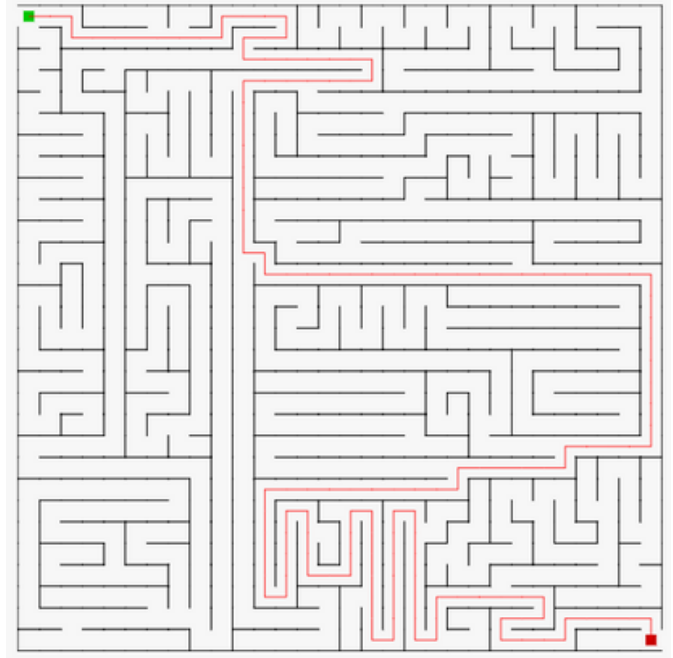
Several more months pass, none of the cats or kittens have been spayed, so Pepper has **7 more kittens**. Her **first litter of kittens has 4 more kittens each, AND her second litter of kittens has 6 kittens each!**

Fall is around the corner, the leaves change colors, and more kittens are born. Pepper has another **litter of 4 kittens, Pepper's first 2 litters all have 5 kittens each.**

What is the total number of cats and kittens?

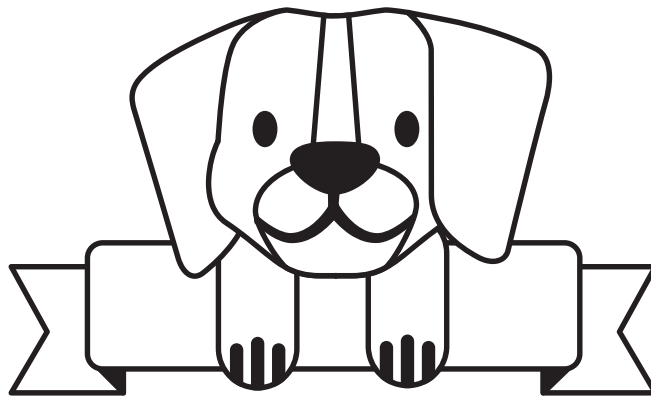
